

NOMINATION PAPER

Ngāti Rehua Ngātiwai ki Aotea Trust



Ngāti Rehua Ngātiwai ki Aotea Trust is calling for nominations for five (5) Trustee positions.

All nomination papers must be received at the Returning Office **no later than 5 pm Friday 24 July 2020**. If there are more candidates than required, an election will be held. If the number of candidates is equal to the number of positions (five), then those persons nominated will be deemed to have been duly appointed as trustees, without the need for an election.

If an election is required, voting packs will be issued to all Adult Registered Members (18 years or over) eligible to vote for the Ngāti Rehua Ngātiwai ki Aotea Trust (as recorded on the Ngāti Rehua Ngātiwai ki Aotea Trust Members' Register as at 5 pm Friday 24 July 2020) from Friday 28 August 2020. Voting will close at 5pm, Tuesday 15 September 2020.

TO BE ELIGIBLE FOR NOMINATION AND ELECTION AS A TRUSTEE, YOU **MUST**:

- descend from at least one of the three significant tupuna for Ngāti Rehua - Rehua, Ranginui and/or Te Awe.
- be 18 years of age or over.
- be recorded in the Ngāti Rehua Ngātiwai ki Aotea Trust Members' Register as an Adult Registered Member.
- get two (2) people to support your nomination, who are 18 years of age or older, also descend from at least one of the three significant tupuna for Ngāti Rehua (Rehua, Ranginui and/or Te Awe), and who are shown as Adult Registered Members on the Ngāti Rehua Ngātiwai ki Aotea Trust Members' Register. You will need to get these people to put their full name, residential address and signature on Section B of the nomination paper.
- consent to the Trust undertaking a Police Check and complete and submit the enclosed Request for Criminal Conviction History - Third Party form with your nomination.

YOU **MUST NOT**:

- be bankrupt; or
- be of unsound mind within the meaning of the Mental Health Act 1969; or
- be convicted of an offence for which the maximum penalty is imprisonment for a term of six months or longer, unless you have served your sentence, or otherwise suffered the penalty imposed on you.

All nomination material must be provided together. Submitted with this nomination, are the following:

- completed nomination paper
- completed 'Request for Criminal Conviction History - Third Party' form
- a candidate profile statement (200 words maximum) detailing experience relevant to the role (optional)
- a recent passport-sized colour photograph (optional)

INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES

CANDIDATES AND NOMINATORS SHOULD READ THIS SHEET CAREFULLY

GENERAL NOTES

1. Nominations of candidates must be in the hands of the Chief Returning Officer no later than **5pm, Friday 24 July 2020**.
2. Members of Ngāti Rehua Ngātiwai ki Aotea Trust cannot nominate themselves.
3. Each candidate must be nominated by TWO Adult Registered Members of Ngāti Rehua Ngātiwai ki Aotea Trust. The two nominators must complete and sign the nomination paper under Section B.
4. Candidates must also complete the attached 'Request for Criminal Conviction History - Third Party' form and submit this with their nomination paper. The Trust will use this information to undertake necessary background checks to ensure candidate suitability. Failure to provide this information will invalidate a nomination.
5. Candidates may provide a candidate profile statement, to include any relevant information, which will be distributed to members with their voting paper.
6. Candidates may provide a passport-sized colour photograph for distribution to members with their voting paper.
7. Candidates are encouraged to lodge their nomination early. Should a nomination paper be lodged late on the afternoon that nominations close, and be incorrectly completed or ineligible nominators are provided, there may be insufficient time to correct the situation and the nomination paper could be invalidated.
8. Nominations materials may be posted to the Chief Returning Officer, Independent Election Services Ltd, PO Box 5135, Victoria Street West, Auckland 1142, or hand delivered to Level 2, 198 Federal Street, Auckland, so as to be received by 5pm, Friday 24 July 2020.
